# FLOOR -TO-CEILING, PLASTIC LAMINATE TOILET PARTITIONS

#### PART 1 – GENERAL

#### 1.1 SECTION INCLUDES

- A. Plastic laminate toilet partitions, floor mounted, overhead braced with brackets required for a complete installation as shown on specified drawings.
- B. Work shall include, but not limited to:
  - 1. Toilet partitions, urinal screens, and privacy panels
  - 2. All required hardware for partitions
  - 3. Shop drawings
  - 4. Manufacturer's guarantee
- C. Related work shall include:
  - 1. Rough Carpentry: Blocking in wall required for proper installation
  - 2. Toilet Accessories

#### 1.2 PRODUCTS

- A. Submit shop drawings and details for architect's approval.
- B. Colors samples shall be submitted for approval by the architect from a spectrum of 37 standard colors. Other laminate manufacturers and colors available upon request.\*

# 1.3 FIELD MEASUREMENTS

A. Field verify dimensions prior to submittals and fabrication.

## PART 2 – PRODUCTS

#### 2.1 MANUFACTURER

A. Toilet partitions and screens to be supplied by Stylecraft Products, Houston, Texas, or approved equal.

## 2.2 FABRICATION

- A. Stylecraft Products strives to maintain current ADA/TAS standards. Emergency access feature is standard.
- B. Doors, panels and urinal screens: Constructed of a sandwich of .048 inch thick high pressure laminate, meeting or exceeding NEMA standards, bonded under pressure to a 45 pound density, resin impregnated industrial particleboard core with a high quality, non-toxic water resistant adhesive. Edges applied first to match face. Doors and Panels: Finish Thickness 1".
- C. Pilasters: Constructed of a sandwich of .048 inch thick high pressure laminate, meeting or exceeding NEMA standards, bonded under pressure to a 45 pound density, resin impregnated

industrial particleboard core with a high quality, non-toxic water resistant adhesive. Edges applied first to match face. Pilasters have to mounting systems with two shoes. Pilasters are anchored and secured to the floor using 3/8" x 3-3/4" wedge-all anchoring systems to pilaster's mounting system comprising of a 3/8" x 1" aluminum bar affixed to the pilaster internally, using 3/8"-16 x 4" zinc tap bolt secured to 3/8"-16 x 7/16" T with 13/16" radius. Pilasters are secured to building structural ceiling by using a L-plate. Pilasters: Finish thickness - 1-1/4".

### D. Hardware:

- 1. Constructed of heavily chrome-plated zamak. Pilasters and panels fit into brackets secured with theft-resistant bolts and barrel nuts. 2 brackets per connection.
- 2. All doors to have emergency access feature.
- 3. Pilaster shoes shall be 4" high, of #302, 18-4 stainless steel.
- E. All factory cutouts to be sealed with water resistant sealant.
- F. Options Available:
  - 1. Continuous aluminum brackets
  - 2. Stainless steel hardware
  - 3. Continuous stainless steel brackets
  - 4. Continuous piano hinge
  - 5. Stainless steel theft-resistant fasteners
  - 6. Steel-core pilasters, using 11ga. steel insert
  - 7. Plywood-core

### **PART 3 – EXECUTION**

### 3.1 INSTALLATION

- A. Install partitions in accordance with layout as shown on shop drawings and manufacturer's installation instructions in a rigid, straight, and plumb manner.
- B. All doors and panels shall be mounted 12" off finished floor nominal.
- C. Adjust non-handicapped doors to remain at a uniformly open position when unlocked at 30 degrees. Handicapped doors to return to closed position.\*\*
- D. Lubricate and clean surfaces.\*\*\*

## 3.2 WARRANTY

- A. Stylecraft Products guarantees our material to be free from defects in material and workmanship with normal cleaning and maintenance under typical conditions for a period of one (1) year from the date of receipt by the customer. (Labor not included in warranty.)
- \* Possible laminate up-charges and extended lead-times due to local availability.
- \*\* Handicapped doors with continuous hinge option cannot be set to the closed position.
- \*\*\*In strict accordance with care and maintenance manual.
